

North Vancouver Conservative Association Sir John A Macdonald Merit Bursary Application

Rules and Instructions

A \$2,000.00 bursary may be awarded by the North Vancouver Conservative Association (NVCA) to a successful applicant graduating from a secondary school who, for three or more of the last five years has been involved in school and community activities and service and who has maintained an acceptable level of academic achievement. Please ensure you have read the Rules and Instructions before completing this application.

- 1. An applicant must be a resident of the **North Vancouver Electoral District** for at least 90 days prior to bursary submission deadline.
 - a. Attendance at a secondary school located within North Vancouver Electoral District is NOT a condition for applying for this bursary.
 - b. Exchange and International students are not eligible to apply for this bursary.
 - c. To determine whether you reside in the current or pending Electoral District, search the interactive map at:

- 2. An applicant must have demonstrated good citizenship, character, and personal initiative.
- 3. The term "last three school years" means the period from July 1 immediately preceding the commencement of Grade 10 to the date of the submission of this application in Grade 12.
- 4. Applicants must complete the application form in full and provide all required information, documents, and letters for their application to be considered. If an applicant requires more space for an answer than is provided on the form, the applicant should continue the answer on a separate sheet of paper.
- 5. Membership in the Conservative Party of Canada is NOT a condition for eligibility for this bursary.
- 6. The bursary is available to students proceeding from Grade 12 to any university, college, technical school, vocational school, or other post-secondary institution approved by the NVCA. The purpose of the bursary is to assist in the funding of the students' post-secondary education.
- 7. Bursaries are conditional in that the funds may be withheld until such time as the recipient provides proof of enrollment in a post-secondary institution approved by the NVCA. A bursary award must be claimed by the recipient from the NVCA no later than September 30 of the year following the recipient's year of graduation.

8. The following must accompany the application:

- a. A letter from the applicant's school principal or counsellor confirming the applicant's character and ability as well as participation in school activities.
- b. A transcript of the applicant's marks for grades 11 and 12 to date, available from your school principal or counsellor, or a copy of your Permanent Record Card. If neither is available, a typed copy of the Permanent Record Card verified by the signature of your school principal or counsellor will be acceptable.
- 9. An applicant must have a minimum "C+" average in their school grades based on the submitted transcript.
- 10. The adjudication process includes a "double blind" system designed to anonymize applicants. This is to eliminate any potential conflicts of interest that could arise. However, immediate relatives of the adjudicating committee are not eligible to apply.
- 11. **The applicant (and guardian) must sign the declaration on the application form**. Each applicant has the responsibility to ensure that the application is complete and accurate, and all required documentation is enclosed

is enclosed. application Email and all relevant material (pdf's preferred) to the NVCA Bursary Committee at info@northvancpc.ca no later than 11:59pm May 10, 2024. The NVCA will not enter into any correspondence with a bursary applicant or their agent. The decision of the NVCA with respect to the awarding of any bursary is final. The NVCA reserves the right to not award a bursary in any year if, in its opinion, there is no suitable applicant.
